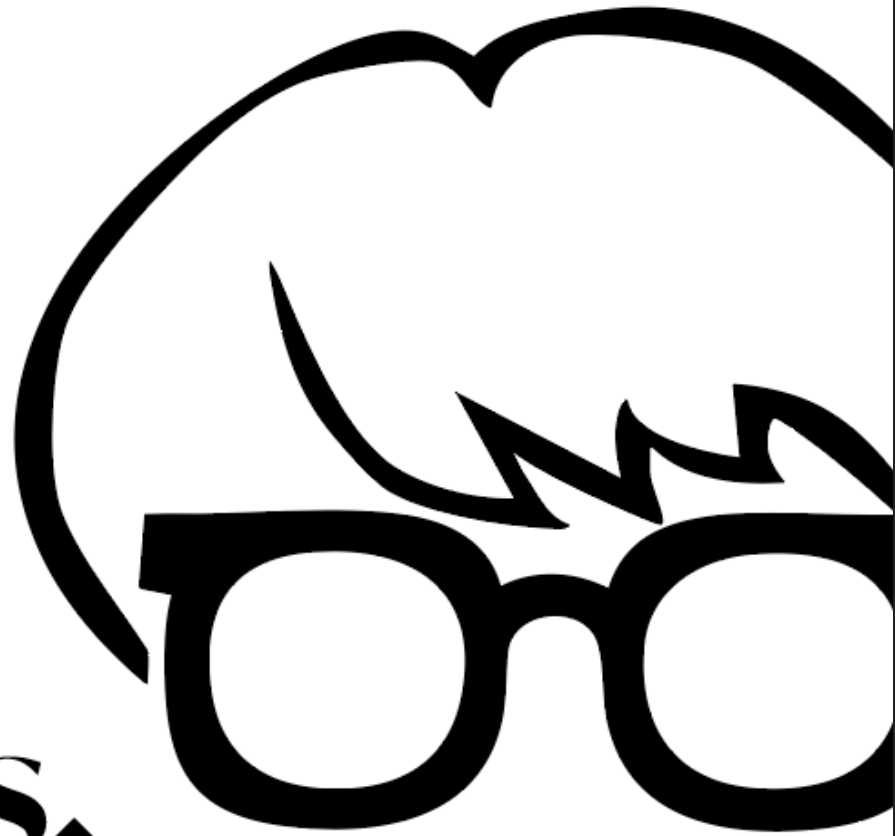

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ABOUT US

The Burns Park Players is more than a stage production, it's an investment in the arts across our entire community. In addition to creating a theater experience for Burns Park elementary school students and the local community, the Burns Park Players has donated over \$300,000 to music and arts programs across all schools in the Ann Arbor School District.

In 2025 alone, the Burns Park Players donated \$13,625 to 29 teachers across 18 schools in the district. These grants put instruments in students' hands, music on their stands, and supplies in their classrooms...from new xylophones at King Elementary, to printmaking equipment at Huron High School, to choir music at Tappan Middle School.

Every grant tells a story: a trumpet player who can finally hold their instrument comfortably, a high school drama program bringing student voices to life on screen, a percussionist with a proper mallet bag, a young flutist able to play thanks to an adaptive instrument. Whether it's a \$150 metronome for Forsythe Middle School or a \$500 world music drumming program at Angell Elementary, each dollar reaches real students in real classrooms
